

READING NOTES THAT MOVE BY STEPS TREBLE CLEF

The names of the notes in music use the letters A - B - C - D - E - F - G.

When notes go **up** the steps, their names go **forward** in the alphabet.

E F G A B C D E F

When notes come **down** the steps, their letter names go **backwards**.

F E D C B A G F E

Look at the first note on each staff below and think of its name.

Remember--the notes in **spaces** use the letters F-A-C-E.

Go forward or backward in the alphabet to name the rest of the notes. Print the letter name of each note on the line under it.

Look at the first note on the staff and think of its name.
Remember--the notes on lines use the letters E-G-B-D-F.

Go forward or backward in the alphabet to name the rest of the notes. Print the letter name of each note on the line under it.

Now finish the page.
Be sure to think of the name of the first note on each staff.
